Encouraged by the result of our last batch wherein out of 2 in NEET one succeeded and is already admitted in MBBS and in JEE six students succeeded and they are already admitted in engineering classes in different reputed colleges, number of admissions in both the coaching classes particularly in NEET has considerably increased. At present, 2 and 26 students are taking coaching of JEE and NEET respectively from our Prayas Social Welfare Society (Regd.).

3--Internship

During the year 2022-23 seven students from various educational institutions have undergone their internship programme with our society. They showed keen interest in the working of the society.

4-- Placement

Six students Aarti, Deepak, Pooja, Rahu, I Pawan and Preeti were the students of computer classes Under VTP of Prayas SWS. Now after completion of the computer course they have informed that they have got employment at various places like school, CP office Govt. HR. Bank, Hospital etc. From Beauty culture classes 5 students informed that they are earning 5 to 10 thousand per month. Out of 5, 3 students are the owner of their own beauty parlour and two are doing job in some other's beauty parlour on salary basis.
